
## WHAT'S HAPPENING

Fens 2100+ | The Fens and coastal lowlands are a unique landscape at the forefront of climate change. The Environment Agency are embarking on a long-term plan for managing future flood risk in the Fens, including developing ways of adapting to flooding and drought. Find out more with members of the Environment Agency's project team.

Lowland Agricultural Peat Small Infrastructure Pilots (LAPSIP) | Come and talk to the ADA team commencing a Defra funded project to provide small capital grants to internal drainage boards in order to develop small scale water level management infrastructure that will serve to enhance the conservation of lowland peat, whilst seeking to not increase the risk of flooding.
